



Hessburg released “Captain Temporium” for iOS, tvOS and macOS

BERLIN, Germany. (November 23, 2016) --- Mark Hessburg today released “Captain Temporium”, a classic *shoot ‘em all up* arcade game. “*I’ve took the original fun and simplicity of the typical early 1980s arcade style of gaming,*” said Hessburg, “*and carefully transformed it into a modern game of the 21st century.*”

Unlike the original classic games “Captain Temporium” features 3D graphics, yet its gameplay is restricted to a 2D plane. The game uses techniques like subtle changing the player’s viewing angle to enhance the 2.5D experience based on the motion of the player’s vessel. Nonetheless as a modern game “Captain Temporium” of course offers all those features like physically based rendering that you would expect from a state-of-the-art title today – the result is an all new fresh look for the original classic fun of the golden age of video gaming.

Gameplay follows a simple arcade concept: The player takes control of a futuristic jet and travels trough time to fight biplanes, warbirds, helicopters, jets, rockets and even UFOs. Each level ends with a final opponent (the boss) which is harder to beat than any of the other aircraft. The overall level of difficulty increases as the game progresses by increasing amount of enemies, the cloud cover and overall speed.

Gameplay:

- A multi-directional scrolling top-down shooter.
- Fire your weapon to kill the enemy until your weapon overheats and needs cooling.
- Defend yourself with the shields but always watch out that you don't run out of shield energy!
- Collect parachutes to get weapon improvements, new shield energy, fuel for the afterburner, bonus lives or bonus score.
- Use the afterburner to escape from enemy bullets or to get a parachute before it disappears.
- Don't fire at the parachutes!
- Some enemies need more hits than others. Some can fire missiles at you.
- The boss at the end of a level can be huge! It takes many hits to kill a boss.
- Hint: if you still have plenty of shield energy then try to ram the boss with your shields.
- Overall speed and number of enemies increases with each level.
- Watch out! The enemy could be behind the clouds, don't run into it! Cloud cover will increase at higher levels and overall visibility will be worse.
